


LA Arboretum (Arcadia) | Tuesday, 4/9

Explore the Los Angeles Arboretum & Botanic Garden in Arcadia, commencing your day with a Self-Guided tour of this 127-acre natural and historical marvel. Immerse yourself in the diverse plant collections, showcasing rare and endangered species from around the globe. Traverse through time as you encounter historical landmarks, including Native American sites, Rancho Period artifacts, and late 19th-century treasures like the iconic Queen Anne Cottage, a familiar backdrop in numerous television shows and movies. Explore additional attractions such as the Santa Anita Train Depot and various exhibits dispersed throughout the garden. Meander through tranquil paths, or unwind by the Mayberg waterfall, fountains, ponds, or themed gardens. Following your visit, experience lunch on your own at Glendora Public Market.


