The purpose of the Youth Commission is to promote the youth of Redondo Beach by providing comprehensive programs and events that meet the interest and need of the youth.

Youth Commission Duties

- Identify and report to the City Council annually on youth needs and priorities of Redondo Beach,
- Remain informed on the programs providing youth services designated to meet the need of Redondo Beach Youth (annually review),
- Research and formulate proposed policies, programs and services designated to meet the need Redondo Beach Youth,
- Review and evaluate requests received by the City pertaining to its youth – related policies/services,
- Maintain liaison with Youth Commissions in other cities, and/or youth – related agencies, and
- Represent the City of Redondo Beach when requested to do so.

Qualifications

Teens must either be Redondo Beach residents or attending a Redondo Beach Unified School, 13 to 18 years old who want to get involved and be able to work effectively with people.

Must attend meetings on the 1st Thursday every other month at 5:30 pm, and participate in other Youth Commission activities.
